

The Bride Event

I want to tell you of things to come. I speak of events to come in the world but also to [My body] the body of Christ.

But consider this, that whatever happens in the world happens on behalf of My body. For I am the summation of all things; that is, all things are to be summed up into Me.

This is an event that will take place in history. It will be an event in time. It will be a worldwide event. It will be an event that affects the whole world. No soul on earth will remain unaffected by the coming forth of My Bride.

This event is inevitable. It is My spoken word in all eternity. It must come to pass and now is. For I have spoken it of old and now call it forth by the power of My Spirit through the voice of My latter-day prophets who are compelled by My Spirit to sound aloud the trumpet—to call forth that which I have ordained from before the foundation of the earth.

All history is to be summed up into Me and My Bride. It is the beginning and the ending of all history. Yet, the ending of history is only the beginning.

This event is taking place now. It is in process now. I am calling forth My Bride now. I see this people and thereby extend My mercy, My grace, My love toward them. I am purging them, purifying them, refining them in the fire of My righteousness.

It can never be a righteousness of their own making. It is My righteousness that I impute to them, knowing very well there is no good thing in them. And they know this as well. So, on their faces they cry out to Me day and night for deliverance. I hear their plea and I answer.

You will begin to see more of the miracles of God come forth in My people for I am doing a mighty work in and through them. This is the most important event in all history. It is the purpose of history being fulfilled in your presence.

Carnal men seek carnal things. They see things and interpret things through their carnal eyes. It is not so with you who are of My Spirit. You are the possessors of the mysteries of God. You hold the secrets of God.

And the greatest of all mysteries is the coming forth of My Bride to both Jew and Gentile—or shall I now say to both Gentile and Jew. For all are made one people who are in Me.

This mystery is being done in secret. It is being worked out in the closets of hearts who secretly call out to Me for help. In the process of time, that which has been in the dark will come into the light; that which has been in secret will be revealed.

Even now, the veil is being lifted and the world begins to anticipate the coming forth of a people of renown. Those with the heart of the Bride are broken by it and come themselves to be a part of her. But those who do not have the heart of the Bride are hardened by what they see and become even hostile to her.

Do not lose heart in the midst of persecution. Only remember that He who has the Bride is the Bridegroom. In the reverse of this, it can also be said she who has the Bridegroom is the Bride. Whoever has the Bridegroom has the victory.

For it is the Bridegroom Himself who comes in glory, riding upon a great white horse, casting down every enemy of God until every foe has been put under foot.

So, do not waste time on the natural, political, historical events you see happening around you, to analyze, criticize, and theologize. These are only that which must take place as preliminary to the greatest event of them all. Rather, look unto Jesus, the author and finisher of your faith, that you yourself might be in that glorious number of whom it is said, "She has made herself ready."

Do not try to perfect yourself in the flesh. Only this, commit your ways unto the Lord that He might show forth His mercy and extend grace to save.
